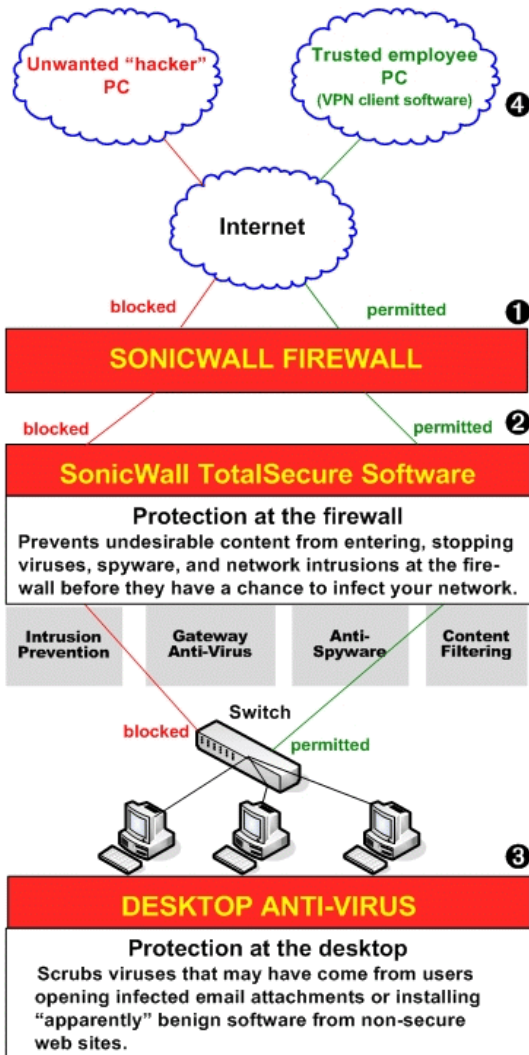


# Fundamentals of Network Security
